


HOT OFF THE BENCH PRESS



Positive Results from Flu Vaccine Trial

Pandemic flu poses an unpredictable threat to the world. The best way to prepare is developing a vaccine to combat H5N1 that reduces the amount of vaccine needed per person and can be easily administered. IDRI, along with partner Medicago, is making progress toward this goal.



At last month's World Vaccine Congress, IDRI's Steven Reed announced positive interim results from a Phase I clinical trial for a H5N1 Avian Influenza vaccine candidate. The vaccine was found to be safe and well-tolerated and induced a solid immune response exceeding the three CHMP (Committee for Medicinal Products for Human Use) criteria for licensing influenza vaccines.
